Swimming Racing Report – includes Masters & Pathway – see also appendix 3 CW handed a draft TBC summary of the **2019 galas** etc (as extracted from the Swimming Secretary's AGM report). Whilst all were in agreement with the dates/venues there was overall dissatisfaction with some aspects of the **event schedule** (as highlighted via various correspondences some weeks previously). The precise detail was not clarified and this is a Swimming Committee issue which must be sorted via our Swimming Committee meeting on September 4th. The draft document will not be published on our website but only the dates/venues, licence numbers & QTs stating that details of the event schedule will be finalised on Sept 4th. LD spent a lot of time preparing the information and was frustrated at receiving minimal feedback when requested, but it is important that these concerns are addressed. .We were optimistic that Lesley Leffers (Swim England licencing officer)will accommodate any changes that might be agreed.
