

Information about facilities and fees

The College provides onsite accommodation for learners aged 16+ as well as students who need to stay for their duty weeks if they are on Equine or Agricultural programmes.

Up to 100 students can be accommodated on a 3,4 or 5 night option (weekends are free with the 5 night option).

The rooms are bright and airy and a fully catered package is available to all students, or self-catered for students over 18 if they wish. Catered meals are provided in the Pastures Restaurant.

Accommodation is allocated on a needs basis, not a "first come first served basis"

Priority is given to the following;

- Students who do not live within a reasonable travelling distance of the College
- Students who require full time term time accommodation
- Students with a disability or support needs
- Returning students

In all instances a guarantor is required who must be over 25 years
