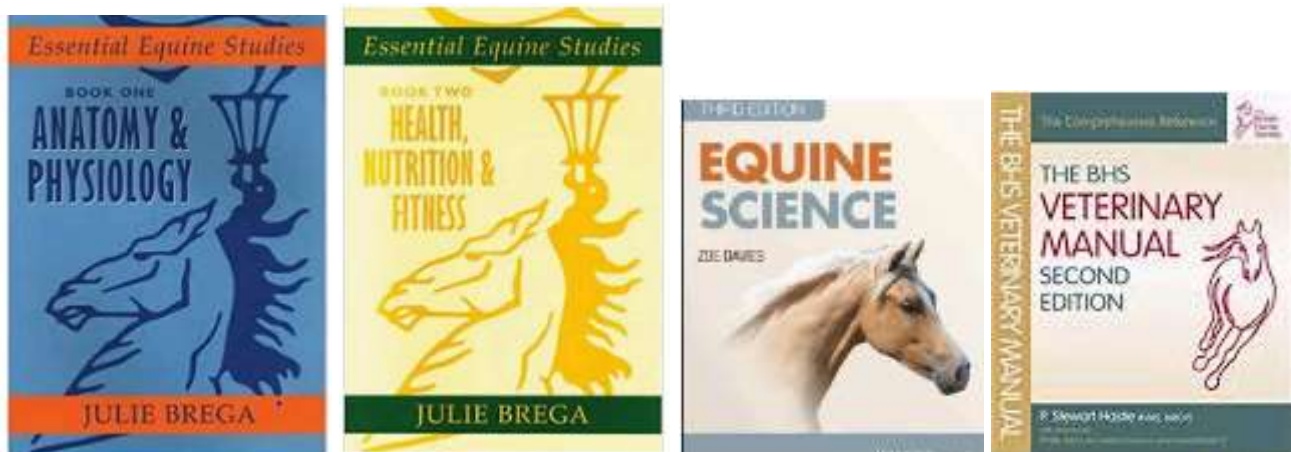


# Welcome to Level 3 Equine Management at Duchy College

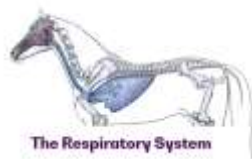

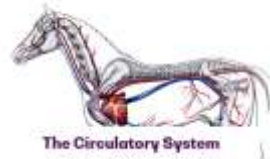
