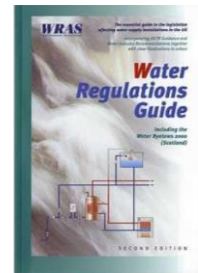
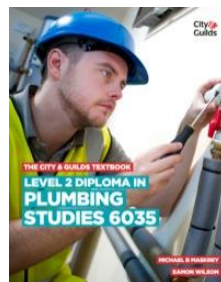
You may have some knowledge in plumbing already or this might be completely new to you. Whatever your starting point, we are ready to support you with your learning.
