WORK EXPERIENCE

A requirement of the course is the work experience unit, which requires you to log 150 hours of external work experience. The work experience block weeks are the week before the Christmas holiday break and the week before the Easter holiday break. It is never too early to start applying for a work experience placement.

- Bicton Uniform is compulsory for all college sessions. Uniform may be plain or branded uniform from our suppliers PVM.
- Minimum clothing suggested:
 - 2x Polo shirts or T Shirts burgundy
 - 1x Jumper (sweatshirt or fleece) burgundy
 - 1x Coat burgundy or 1x Gilet burgundy
- Steel toe capped safety boots / Wellington boots with steel toe caps
- Waterproof coat
- Waterproof trousers (optional)
- Work type trousers/black jeans should be worn, but ripped jeans or jogging bottoms/leggings are not allowed
- Washable face mask for working in required animal areas
- No jewellery is to be worn during practical sessions, it must be removed (this includes all piercings)

PLEASE NOTE: uniform is expected to be worn on all college days, whether you are in practical or theory sessions. There are strict rules surrounding PPE for student and animal safety which have been outlined at interview and will be discussed further in Welcome Week.

If you already have black Bicton uniform from last year, you can continue to wear it, there is no expectation for you to buy the new burgundy uniform unless you want to.
